Invitation to the Lord's Table

Prayer of Great Thanksgiving

Leader: The Lord be with you.

People: And also with you.

Leader: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them to the Lord.

Leader: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Leader: Great and loving God, there are no spirits at this table so holy as your Holy Spirit, but there are many other spirits here with us, you know, and we are grateful for the thought of each and every one: there is the spirit of Abraham here, chin set toward your promise, and of Sarah laughing all the way. There is the spirit of Moses here, staff in one hand and tablet in the other, and of Rahab dressed in her bangles and beads ready to rescue. There is the spirit of Jeremiah here with fire in his mouth, and of Gomer with the taste of being forgiven in hers. There is the spirit of King David here with a sling to slay the giants, and of Bathsheba here to tame the king. There is the spirit here of Simon and the others with their late but strong belief, and

of Mary Magdalene who was the very first to believe. These are all present at the table in spirit, plus the spirit of apostles, martyrs, and reformers more than we can name or number. When we think of it, it's quite a company with whom we cavort and feast and laugh and pray our prayer of great thanks. Bless this rich and savory food that it will nourish us soon and again in the clear memory of it all. Therefore we praise you, joining our voices with choirs of angels, with prophets, apostles, and martyrs, and with all the faithful if every time and place, who forever sing to the glory of your name:

People: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

Leader: You are holy, O God of majesty, and blessed is Jesus Christ, your Son, our Lord. In Jesus, born of Mary, your Word became flesh and dwelt among us, full of grace and truth. He lived as one of us, knowing joy and sorrow. He healed the sick, fed the hungry, opened blind eyes, broke bread with outcasts and sinners, and proclaimed the good news of your kingdom to the poor and needy.
