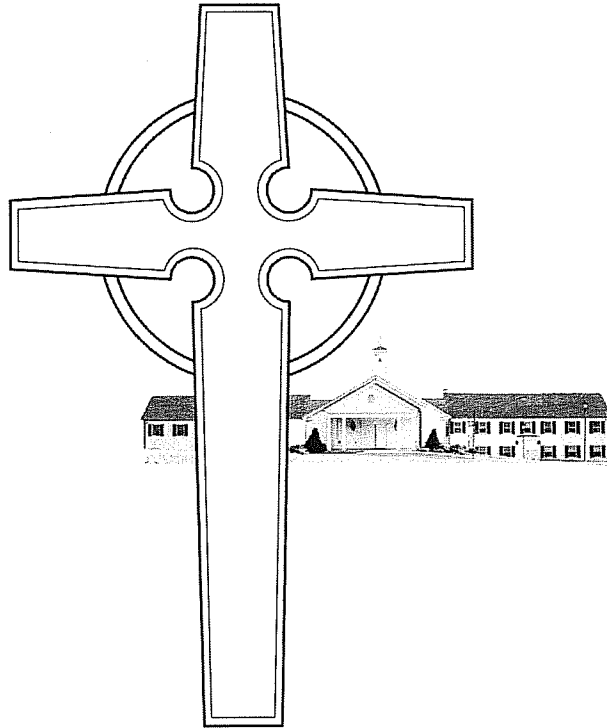

PRESBYTERIAN DISASTER ASSISTANCE (PDA) has already begun to respond to the 7.0 Earthquake in Haiti.
