**PRESBYTERIAN DISASTER ASSISTANCE (PDA)** has already begun to respond to the 7.0 Earthquake in Haiti. Funds from the One Great Hour of Sharing (Easter) Offering enable Presbyterians to respond on a moment's notice to disasters around the world. This allows our disaster response teams to swing into action at once following disasters such as the earthquake last Tuesday or the hurricane in 2008 that have struck this poor nation. Ongoing recovery efforts - particularly the long term coordination of response for which PDA is particularly known - will require additional gifts from members and friends of the PC(USA). The VERY best way we can help the people of Haiti now is through our generous gifts to PDA and our prayers to God on their behalf.

**GUEST PREACHER NEXT SUNDAY:** Travis B. Winckler entered college at the University of Sioux Falls as a theology and philosophy major. He followed his academic interests to Oxford University (UK) where he studied philosophy and medieval church history. Travis's call to ministry led him to Princeton Theological Seminary where his interests in theology and pastoral ministry were increasingly shaped and informed by political and social concerns. While a seminary student, Travis served an urban church in Seattle, WA, studied religion and politics as a congressional assistant in Washington DC, and administered pastoral care as a chaplain assistant at a psychiatric hospital in New Jersey. On November 15, 2009 he was called as Associate Pastor of New York City's Broadway United Church of Christ.
