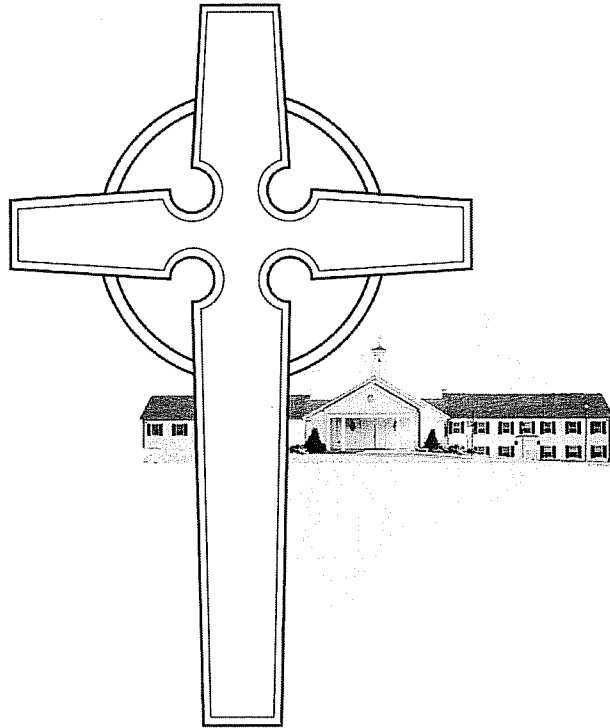

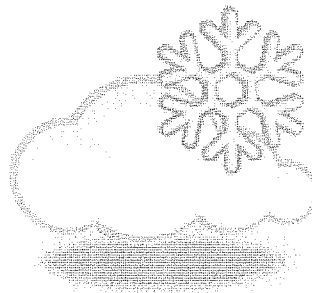

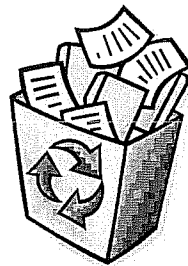
FLOWER SPONSORS are needed in the new year. Sign-up sheets are on the bulletin board downstairs.
