FELLOWSHIP AT THE LORD'S TABLE

Invitation to the Lord's Table

Leader: Before us is the meal. As a people of faith, we approach this table with humility and joy. Ours is a community who claims Jesus Christ as the source of power in our lives; and it is in Christ's name that we strike down the barriers between us and invite all who come in love to approach the table as sisters and brothers.

Communion Prayer

Leader: God be with you.

People: And also with you.

Leader: Lift up your hearts.

People: We lift them up to the Lord.

Leader: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Leader: Holy God, you speak to us in silence, yet all languages interpret you. Because you call us to be in community, we are able to become gifts to one another. We invoke now your Holy Spirit upon us and upon these gifts, that in sharing them, we may discern your presence which becomes our life.

A loaf is made from varied ingredients that are gathered together and made one, so too are we, in all our diversity, drawn together around your table as we are made one.

As grapes are scattered throughout the hillside and gathered together and made one, so too we, your people who are scattered throughout Upper Bucks are gathered together and transformed into your life blood for all.

As we prepare to eat of the loaf and drink from the cup may our participation in this meal help transform us into the body of Christ we share.

And now with confidence, we pray together the prayer that Jesus taught us:

Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever. Amen.

The Words of Institution
