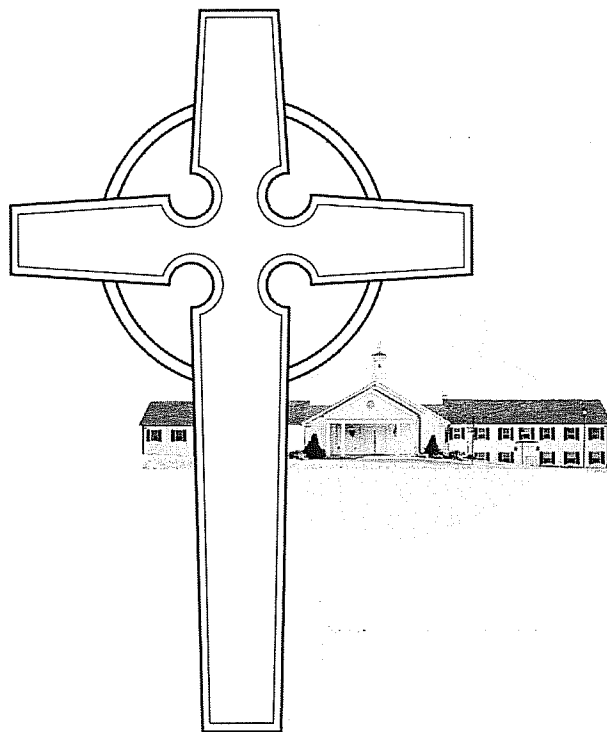

**THANK YOU TO ALL WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE ALL-CHURCH WORK DAY ON JULY 10<sup>TH</sup>**. We were able to complete the following projects:

#### **Manse**

- Large Hemlock trees were taken down, cleaned up along with several other smaller trees.
- The two large maple trees in the front yard were trimmed up.

- The front of the house was pressure washed
- The front and sides were mulched
- The Yew bushes on the front were trimmed.

**Church**

- All the windows were cleaned except for the Sunday school Wing. They look great!!!!!!!!!!
- The bushes were trimmed back to window sill height.
- The big nasty bushes overgrowing the Nursery school windows were removed and the stumps removed as well.
- The large Locust tree by the church was trimmed up.
- The smaller dogwoods and a sundry of other trees were pruned back.
- The flower beds and trees were mulched. We used 30 yards of triple ground black dyed mulch!!!!!!
- Some of the dead limbs were pruned back in the grove.
- The black walnut trees overhanging the Red School House were trimmed back.
- The slate roof was repaired on the red school house.
- The old benches in the Playground were removed and discarded.
- The playground equipment was spruced up a bit.
- There were numerous wasp nests eradicated.
- Many of the trees were pruned back in the grove.
- Many of the smaller bushes were trimmed, shaped and mulched

I do believe, had it not rained, we would have had a better turnout and more would have been accomplished. The participation and fellowship we enjoyed together as a congregation was wonderful. Again our hats off to all those who showed up and lent a hand!!!! - Walt Murphy
