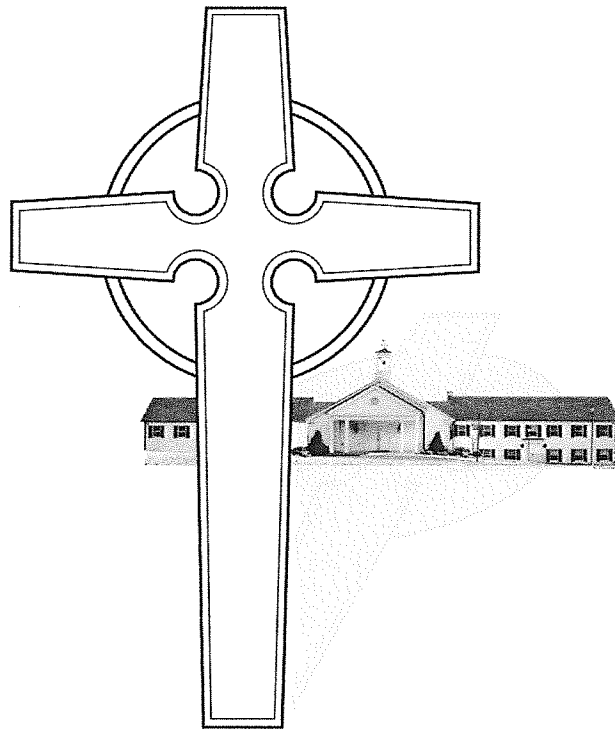

- May 31st - Noise - How can we hear God through the noise around us?

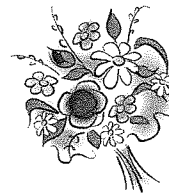

CHANGE IN WORSHIP SCHEDULE From now until Father's Day, the second service will begin at **10:45 AM**.
